## CAMP LACKAWANNA Camper & Staff Checklist

- \_\_\_ underwear (at least 1 set for everyday)
- \_\_\_ pajamas
- \_\_\_ 6-10 pairs of socks (can't have too many)
- \_\_\_ 2-3 pairs of jeans
- \_\_\_ 3- 5 pairs of shorts
- \_\_\_ 6-7 T-shirts
- \_\_\_ 1-2 long sleeve shirt
- \_\_\_ 1 jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt
- \_\_\_ 1 hat or cap
- \_\_\_ 1 raincoat/poncho
- \_\_\_ 1 good, 1 old pair of sneakers
- \_\_\_ 1 every day pair, 1 old pair to get muddy
- \_\_\_ swim suit (extra one, if you got it)

- \_\_\_ toiletry articles (shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste.
- \_\_\_ at least 2 towels and washcloths
- \_\_\_ pillow, sleeping bag or 2 heavy blankets and sheets
- \_\_\_ laundry bag
- \_\_\_ flashlight (with new batteries), bug spray, sun screen
- \_\_\_ sports equipment (baseball glove, etc.)
- \_\_\_ Bible, pencils, pen, notebook or journal
- \_\_\_ Light Weight Back Pack (like for school) (to carry stuff while away from cabin)
- \_\_\_ note paper, envelopes, stamps (for letters home)
- \_\_\_ books, magazines, (for quiet times)
- \_\_\_ money for Summer Mission Offering (collections taken at registration and closing)
- \_\_\_ medications (please give to the Nurse upon arrival at Camp)
- \_\_\_ Don't forget to bring your Smile and a great attitude!

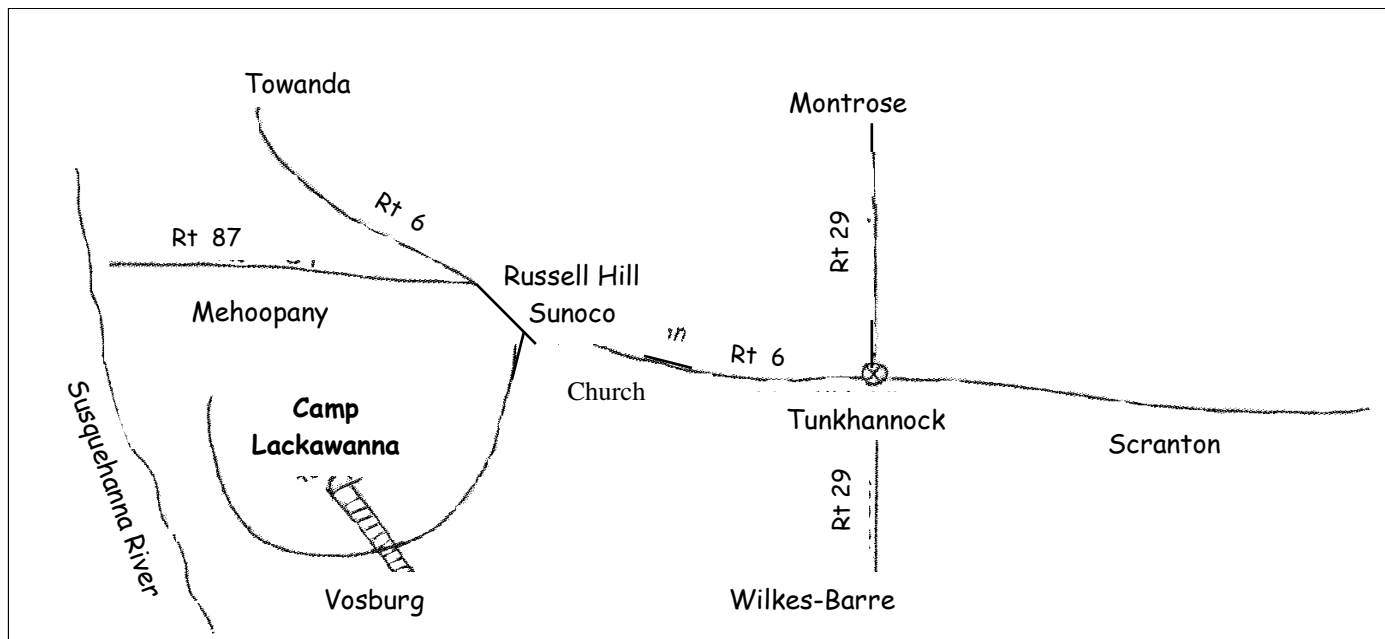
### PLEASE NOTE

### Directions to Camp Lackawanna

#### From the East

Five (5) miles west of Tunkhannock on US Route 6, turn left at the SUNOCO (used to be a TEXACO) Station, beside a little white church. Travel five (5) miles on this road, which leads to the camp entrance. There is a traffic light at the intersection.

#### From the West

Just beyond the intersection of Route 87, turn right at the SUNOCO (used to be a TEXACO) Station. Travel 5 miles on this road which leads to the camp entrance. There is a traffic light at the intersection.
